Beyond Numbers: *This Is What You've helped us do since the war began in Gaza to the end of August 2025*

- 1,158,908 Outpatient consultations
- 347,357 Emergency room consultations
- 81,786 Non-communicable disease consultations
- 76,064 People treated for diarrhea
- 66,758 Prenatal consultations
- 65,303 Individual mental health sessions
- 56,034 Inpatients admitted
- 27,365 Surgeries
- 15,404 Births assisted



Two years have passed, but our dedication to saving lives has not have been eroded by time. It continues—wherever the need is greatest. We recall the note from Krystal to mark one year since the Gaza war began:

“ How could people in Gaza live through the 8,784 hours? With the sound of drones as the background music of everyday life, there was no moment of peace in the Gaza Strip. There was no miracle, not enough drinking water and not enough food. People are forced to relocate countless times to escape from bombardment...



Another 8,784 hours have passed. The situation has not improved—on the contrary, it has worsened. Gaza is filled with displaced people seeking shelter among the rubble. Resources are critically scarce, famine alarms continue to ring, bombings strike without warning, and what we stand for as humanitarians is being challenged every day.

But because of you,

Over these 17,568 hours—two years—our teams have remained steadfast on the front lines in Gaza. From the moment the all-out war erupted, and as destruction continues to spread across the Strip, we have stood by the people in distress.
